



IMPORTANT COLLECTION INFORMATION

Your new automated curbside collection program schedule starts **October 1, 2019**

Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays are the only two holidays observed. Garbage will be collected outside your cart Friday, Saturday, and Monday after Thanksgiving and from December 26th to January 1st following Christmas day.

ALL CARTS, BINS, CANS, AND OTHER DEBRIS MUST BE PLACED OUT BY 6 A.M. ON YOUR COLLECTION DAY.

GARBAGE - All garbage must be placed inside your SWA cart, there is no weight limit. This includes coconuts and all other fruits.

YARD WASTE - Yard waste is limited to a **maximum of 6 cubic yards per week**. All yard waste, with the exception of tree branches and palm fronds must be properly containerized in standard 32-50 gallon cans or sealed bags that weigh less than 50 lbs. when filled. Tree branches cannot exceed 50 lbs. in weight, 6 feet in length, and 6 inches in diameter per piece.

Tree removal, tree trunks, root balls are never collected curbside.

BULK - Bulk includes appliances, furniture, and any other items that do not fit in your garbage cart, and is limited to 3 items per week.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS (C&D) - C&D is limited to 2 cubic yards per week. All C&D must be in containers and weigh less than 50 lbs. when filled.

Blue Bin	Plastic bottles and containers, cans, glass bottles and jars, cartons, drink boxes
Yellow Bin	Cardboard, newspapers, office and school paper, mail, magazines, dry food boxes, paper bags, cardboard paper rolls, pizza boxes

Never recycled: *Plastic bags, foam products, aluminum foil/pans, shredded paper, plastic utensils/straws, paper towels/plates/napkins, coat hangers, light bulbs, or needles.*
